**EXEMPTIONS FROM PART 1**

1. A pass at Parts A (or Part 1 MFGDP(UK) since 1998) and B of the MFDS/MFD (Regulations January 2001, updated December 2005) held by one of the Royal Colleges of the UK and Ireland. Part 2 must be passed within five years of passing Part B.
2. A pass at Part 1 of the MFD of the Royal College of Surgeons of Ireland. Part 2 must be passed within five years of passing Part 1.
3. A pass at Part 1 of the MJDF of the Royal College of Surgeons of England. Part 2 must be passed within five years of passing Part 1.
4. A pass at Part A MFDS/MFD (or Part 1 MFGDP(UK) since 1998) and a Pass in the Coursework Module of the MFGDP (UK). Part 2 must be passed within five years of obtaining the Coursework Module.

**NOTES**

- Candidates are eligible to apply for Part 2, provided that the Part 2 closing date is within five years of having passed the exempting qualification.
- Candidates who are unable to pass Part 2 within the prescribed five-year time limit may re-enter the examination at Part 1.
