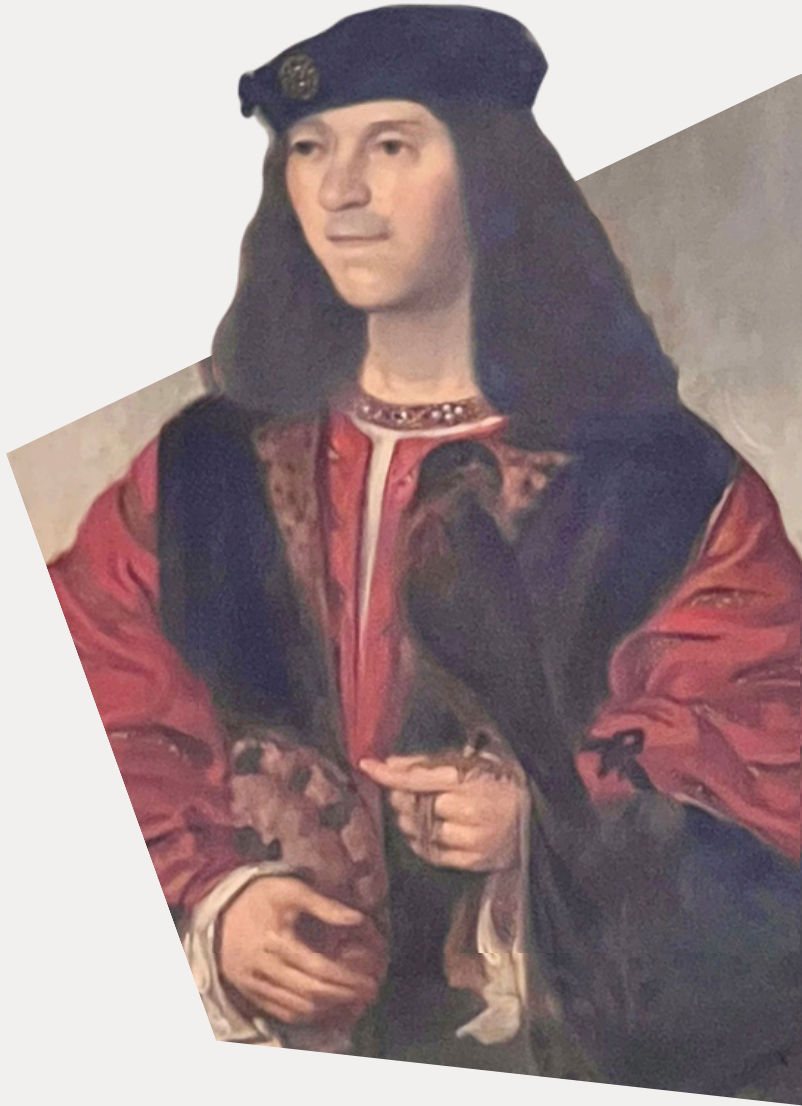

# The Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh King James IV Professorship

---

The Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh has enjoyed a continuous existence as corporate body since 1505 when the Barber Surgeons of Edinburgh were formally incorporated as a Craft Guild of the Burgh. This recognition is embodied in the Seal of Cause or Charter of Privileges granted to the Barber Surgeons by the Town Council of Edinburgh on 1 July 1505, allowing them to practice surgery within the city.

The Seal of Cause was confirmed under the Privy Seal on 13 October 1506 by King James IV of Scotland. The King had an interest in all matters scientific, including medicine and surgery, and was particularly proud of his skill as a dental surgeon, adopting the somewhat unusual practise of paying the patients who he operated on.

To mark the Millennium, The Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh proposed the establishment of a professorship to be awarded annually by the College in open competition to practitioners of Surgery or Dental Surgery who have made a significant contribution to the clinical and/or scientific basis of surgery over an extended period of their consultant career and have acquired a national or international reputation, and that they be called King James IV Professorships.

Two Professorships may be awarded annually, one to a Surgical Fellow, and one to a Dental Fellow of the College. The courtesy title of King James IV Professor made permissible by the approval of the late Queen Elizabeth II will be accorded to King James IV Professors for the duration of the College year in which their lecture is delivered.

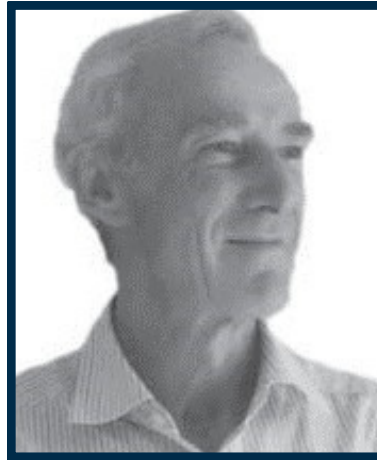

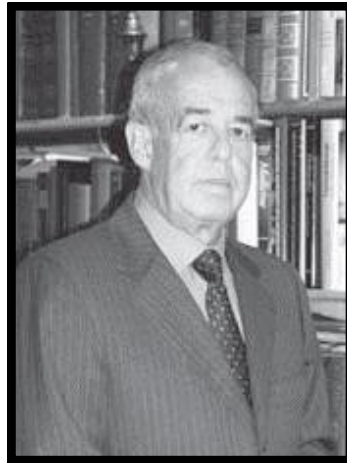

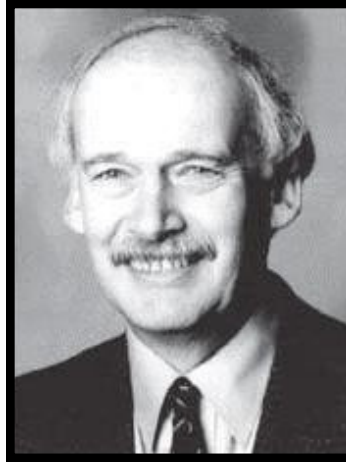
