Introduction:

The Faculty of Remote, Rural and Humanitarian, part of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh (RCSEd), is committed to protecting your personal data in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018. This notice explains how and why we collect, use and protect your personal information when you interact with us, attend events or use our services.

Who Are We:

We process your personal data under one or more of the following legal bases:

- **Consent:** When you provide clear, informed permission (e.g. marketing emails)
- Contract: When processing is necessary to fulfil a service you requested
- Legal obligation: To meet our statutory and regulatory duties
- Legitimate interest: To manage operations and improve services (balanced with your rights).

Special category data (e.g. health) is processed only with explicit consent under Article 9(2)(a) UK GDPR or where necessary for significant public interest under Article 9(2)(g).

How We Use Your Information:

We use your information to:

- Identify and appoint appropriately qualified and experienced volunteers
- Facilitate communication and coordination between Faculty members, volunteers, and the wider College
- Manage volunteer roles, responsibilities, and contributions
- Recruit and retain members with an interest or expertise in remote, rural and humanitarian healthcare
- Support member engagement and participations in Faculty activities
- Ensure transparency, accountability, and good governance
- Enable access to relevant systems, training, and support
- Recognise and record volunteer engagement and service

Sharing Your Information:

We will on occasion share a reasonable amount of personal data with third parties in order to carry out its activities. We will only share the minimal amount of data necessary for the agreed purposes and will use and continue to develop robust data sharing agreements with the said third parties. We never sell your personal data.

Information may be share with:

- Faculty assessors
- Membership, Marketing and Communications team
- Exams and Education team
- Public bodies, when legally required

We may, depending on your geographical location, share or transfer information with our Malaysian subsidiary, RCSEd Malaysia Sdn. Bhd for the purpose of carrying out RCSEd activities within the ASEAN region. Such transfers are carried out with appropriate safeguards to ensure that your personal data is adequately protected in accordance with applicable data protection law, and in particular Article 46 of the UK GDPR and the EU GDPR.

Retention of Your Data:

We will keep your personal data for no longer than is necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected and to satisfy any legal, regulatory, accounting or reporting requirements. We regularly review our data retention schedules and apply secure disposal methods when data is no longer needed.



Your Rights:

You have rights under data protection law, including to:

- Access your data
- Correct inaccurate data
- Request erasure (where legally permissible)
- Restrict or object to processing
- Withdraw consent at any time (where processing is based on consent)
- Lodge a complaint with the ICO (www.ico.org.uk)
