#### Introduction:

The Faculty of Dental Surgery (FDS), part of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh (RCSEd), is committed to protecting your personal data in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018. We process your personal data under one or more of the following legal bases:

- **Contract:** When processing is necessary to fulfil a service, you requested.
- Legal obligation: To meet our statutory and regulatory duties
- Legitimate interest: To manage operations and improve services (balanced with your rights).

#### **Sharing Your Information:**

We will on occasion share a reasonable amount of personal data with third parties in order to carry out its activities. We will only share the minimal amount of data necessary for the agreed purposes and will use and continue to develop robust data sharing agreements with the said third parties. We never sell your personal data.

- UK and International organisations, including but not limited to the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons, the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong, the American Board of Oral Medicine.
- International universities for a variety of conjoint speciality and non-speciality exams.
- Other UK Royal Surgical Colleges (England, Glasgow and Ireland) for Intercollegiate Speciality Fellowship Examinations.
- Key governmental stakeholders worldwide

We may, depending on your geographical location, share or transfer information with our Malaysian subsidiary, RCSEd Malaysia Sdn. Bhd for the purpose of carrying out RCSEd activities within the ASEAN region. Such transfers are carried out with appropriate safeguards to ensure that your personal data is adequately protected in accordance with applicable data protection law, and in particular Article 46 of the UK GDPR and the EU GDPR.

#### **Retention of Your Data:**

We will keep your personal data for no longer than is necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected and to satisfy any legal, regulatory, accounting or reporting requirements. We regularly review our data retention schedules and apply secure disposal methods when data is no longer needed. Contact us if they want the retention schedule.

#### **Your Rights:**

You have rights under data protection law, including to:

- Request erasure (where legally permissible)
- Restrict or object to processing
- Withdraw consent at any time (where processing is based on consent)
