

Obtaining Accreditation of Prior Learning from UCLan

The Faculty of Pre-Hospital Care has an agreement with the University of Central Lancashire (UCLan) for 120 credits to be awarded at level 7 which can be used towards an MSc in Urgent Care. These credits will be given to successful candidates in the **FPHC Diploma in Urgent Medical Care (Dip UMC RCSEd)** when they register to study for the additional 60 Level 7 Credits to complete the MSc (preparation module – either Research Methods or Evidence-Based Practice - both 20 credit modules followed by either the Dissertation or Professional Project module, each of which are 40 credits). These Credits would only be awarded after application and acceptance onto the MSc in Urgent Care program.
